**ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION FOR ENTRY OF AN ORDER AUTHORIZING
AND APPROVING THE EMPLOYMENT OF PACHULSKI STANG ZIEHL
& JONES LLP AS CO-COUNSEL TO THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF
UNSECURED CREDITORS NUNC PRO TUNC TO AUGUST 18, 2008**

Upon consideration of the Application for Entry of an Order Authorizing and Approving the Employment of Pachulski Stang Ziehl & Jones LLP as Co-Counsel to the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors Nunc Pro Tunc to August 18, 2008 (the "Application")² filed by the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors appointed in the above-captioned cases (the "Committee"), and upon the Affidavit of Laura Davis Jones in Support of Application for Order Authorizing and Approving the Employment of Pachulski Stang Ziehl & Jones LLP as Co-Counsel to the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors Nunc Pro Tunc to August 18, 2008, a managing partner of the Firm, in support thereof (the "Jones Affidavit"); and the Court being satisfied based on the representations made in the Application and in the Jones Affidavit that said attorneys represent no interest adverse to the Debtors' estates with respect to the matters upon which they are to be engaged, that they are disinterested persons as that term is defined under



Section 101(14) of the Bankruptcy Code, as modified by section 1103(b) of the Bankruptcy Code, and that their employment is necessary and would be in the best interests of the Debtors' estates, and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefore;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Application is GRANTED.
2. In accordance with sections 1102, 1103, 328, and 504 of the Bankruptcy Code and Bankruptcy Rules 2014, 2016, and 5002, the Committee is authorized to employ and retain Pachulski Stang Ziehl & Jones LLP ("PSZJ") as co-counsel *nunc pro tunc* to August 18, 2008, on the terms set forth in the Application and the Jones Affidavit.
3. PSZJ shall be entitled to allowance of compensation and reimbursement of expenses, upon the filing and approval of interim and final applications pursuant to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, the Local Rules of Bankruptcy Practice and Procedure of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware, and such other orders as this Court may direct.
