

Debtors' Motion to Reject Unexpired lease of Personal Property *Nunc Pro Tunc* to May 31, 2009 (the "Rejection Motion")

By the Rejection Motion, the Debtors seek entry of an order authorizing them to reject a contract (the "GE Contract") with GE Capital Fleet Services ("GE") under which the Debtors lease 50 vehicles (the "Vehicles") for use in the Debtors' daily operations, retroactive to May 31, 2009.

The Debtors maintain that due to reductions in their business operations, the majority of the Vehicles are underutilized. While the Debtors anticipate needing approximately half of the vehicles for future operations, the GE Contract is inclusive of all the Vehicles and the Debtors cannot reject individual Vehicles. Accordingly, the Debtors have determined that the GE Contract is unnecessary and burdensome to their estates, and the Debtors should reject the GE Contract in order to avoid the expense of leasing the underutilized Vehicles, and undertake obligations related to the Vehicles' fuel, insurance and repairs. Upon rejection of the GE Contract, the Debtors expect to enter into post-petition agreements for a reduced number of Vehicles, at a savings of approximately \$7,000 per month.
