

Motion of Eastern Waste Systems, Inc. for Allowance and Immediate Payment of Administrative Expense Claim (the “EWS Motion”)

By the EWS Motion, Eastern Waste Systems, Inc. (“EWS”) seeks entry of an order allowing EWS’s postpetition administrative expense claims and directing the Debtors to pay such allowed claims immediately.

EWS maintains that the Debtors owe it (i) \$76,869.00 (the “Claim”) for postpetition waste removal services (the “Services”) that EWS provided to the Debtors at The Regent Bal Harbour (“Bal Harbour”).

EWS maintains that the Claim is entitled to administrative expense priority because (i) Bal Harbour confirmed receipt of the Services by signing invoices, and (ii) the transactions benefited the Debtors by allowing Bal Harbour to continue to operate. Furthermore, EWS asserts that the Court should compel the Debtors to pay the Claim immediately because such payment would not prejudice the Debtors or their other creditors, but otherwise, EWS would suffer hardship of not being compensated.
